How to insert a product?

How to include order page and order page settings?

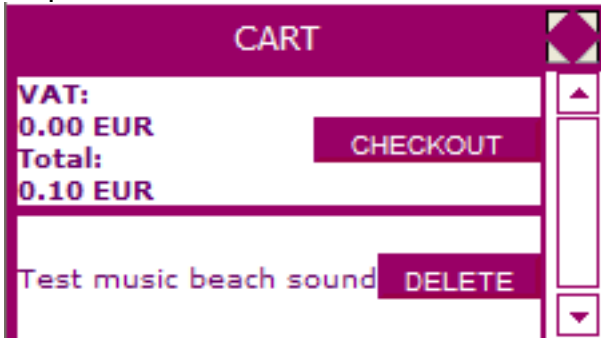

1. Enter the exact file name for your order page and click Ok.
2. Click on the file name to your order page.
3. Choose from the use of "buy now" buttons or "Order window and order buttons" on your order page.
4. Select a currency for your order page (if any of your products are set up with a different currency will there be made an automatic currency conversion)
5. "Auto" appears as the default language, it means that there will be automatically selected language for the information that your customer's web browser is set up with (applicable for your buttons and order window). You have the opportunity to choose a fixed language, as always will be used for the order page.
6. **Only** by the use of "Order window and order buttons"
Here you have the opportunity to choose in which corner of your order page "Order window" should be.
Default is "Left Bottom"
(There is also a button on the "Order window" where your customers are able to move it to another corner)



7. Color choices for the "Order window", buttons, product text
You can use the [color selection box](#) by clicking the "COLOR" button or enter the hexadecimal color number, 6 digits + # in the text box. Color settings for Musicstore.html will provide an "Order window" as shown below.



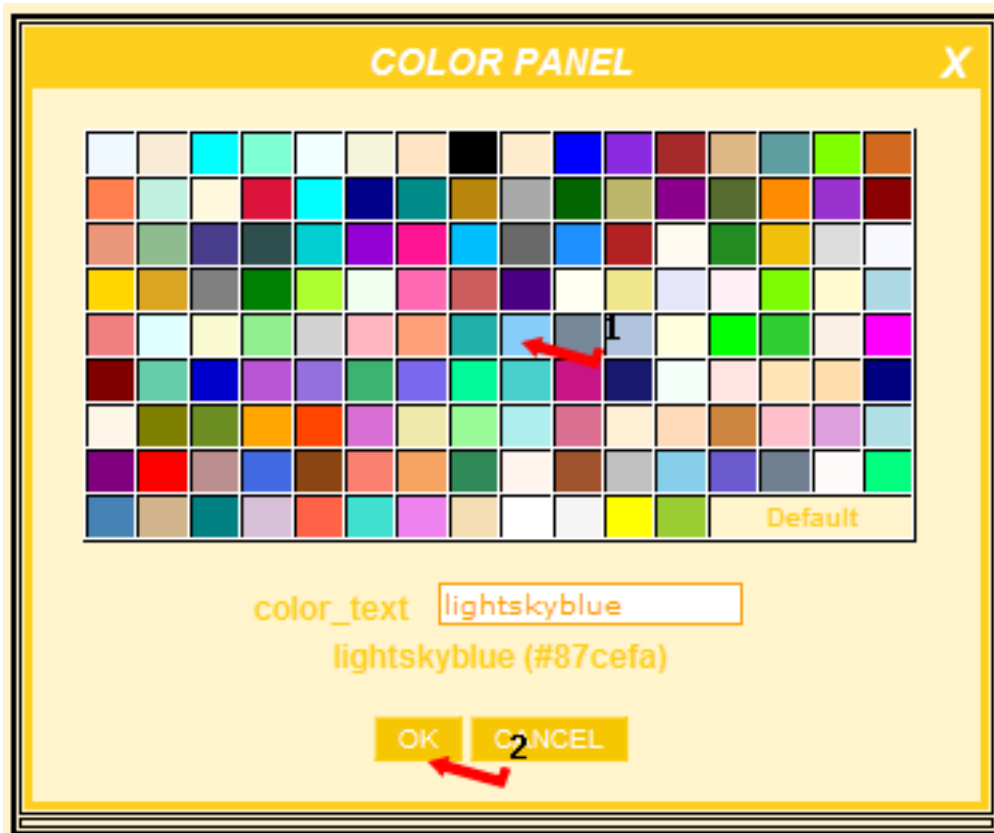

9. Click to delete the order page and settings from Digi4Pay database.

How to use the color window?

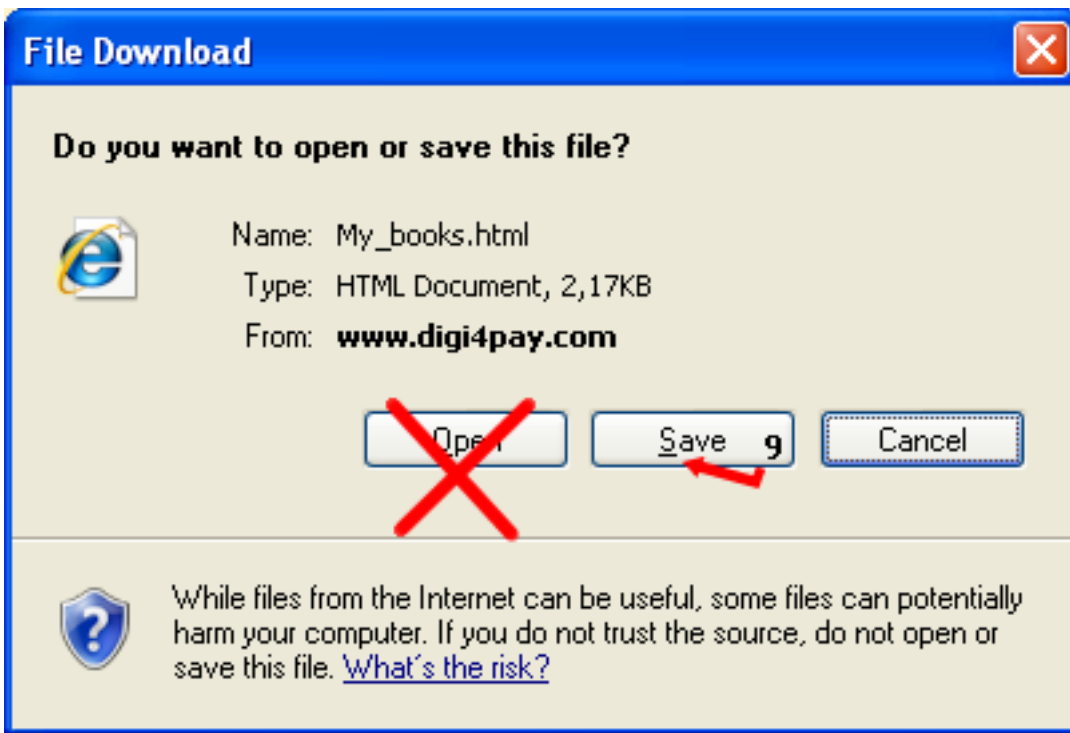



1. Print transaction log
2. Go forward or back between pages, using the dropdown or buttons
3. You can sort the transaction log, by clicking the field name you wish to sort on.
4. You can highlight a specific transaction by clicking on the transaction. It makes it easier to monitor transactions through the large number of fields.

How will I know it's been made a purchase?

You will receive a copy of the download email (in your language), which is sent to your customer.

All information about transactions will appear in your transaction log.

Also, PayPal will send out an email about a purchase has been made.

How to sell digital goods on eBay?



1. Click on eBay in the "more ..." menu.
